Chandler Prep at MATHCOUNTS Contest

Chandler Prep finished 7th out of 19 schools represented at the MATHCOUNTS competition with a total team score of 32.5/66 possible points. The highest place finisher for Chandler Prep was Isaac Kan with 13th place overall.

Chandler Prep Students Earn Spots in All-Region Choir/Band/Orchestra

On January 27, 16 individual Chandler Prep High School music students earned spots in the All-Region Choir/Band/Orchestra ensembles. Students prepared for these auditions on their own time, and the live auditions include the highest musicianship skills such as solo performance, scales, and sight reading.
